Medical Waiver Packet Instructions

Professional drivers requesting waiver of the CPV Medical standards must complete the following:

Step 1. A completed application for a professional driver's medical waiver to the CPV administrator

Step 2. Per 20 CBJAC 40. 310(a), the application shall be submitted 30 days prior to the expiration of their professional driver's permit, Per 20 CBJAC 40.120(c), a late application fee of \$50.00, will be charged to applicants failing meet the 30 day time frame .

Step 3. The application for a professional driver's medical is available at the Juneau Police Department Monday through Friday 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. or from the CBJ web site at www.juneau.org. Tab on the following links from the home page. City links, quick links, police, forms and documents.

Once the waiver has been signed by the City Manager it will be returned to the CPV Administrator. The CPV Administrator will complete the review process and notify the applicant of the results. If approved, a permit will be issued. If denied the applicant will receive a written notice.
