Dear Business Owner,

The Juneau Police Department is using LeadsOnline to satisfy the reporting requirement contained in City and Borough of Juneau Code 20.05.010 through 20.05.130 (attached) which goes into effect on September 11, 2014. This reporting process has in the past been used for pawn shops and now is extended to secondhand dealers.

As you may know, LeadsOnline is a web-based, secure Electronic Data Transfer (EDT) service designed by business owners and law enforcement agencies to facilitate the recovery of missing personal property.

The Juneau Police Department asks that you *register your store(s) online at www.leadsonline.com before September 11, 2014.* Registration takes less than two minutes total. LeadsOnline will then contact you with easy instructions for electronically uploading daily transactions. Uploading is a very simple and secure process taking less than 30 seconds per day, and their service is FREE to you and customers.

During the process of passing this new ordinance, it came to the attention of the Juneau Police Department that many secondhand dealers were unaware of the state requirements regulating that business. A copy Alaska Statute, Title 8, Chapter 76 is being included in this packet for your convenience.
